

SHEPERDS HEY – Limewash and Distemper

Challenge

To restore the exterior of a large 1930's listed thatched property in the Charles Rennie Mackintosh 'Art and Craft' style. The external elevations are primarily rendered in Portland cement based stuccowork with black and tile dressings.

Solution

The stucco was heavily soiled with atmospheric and biological deposits. Following paint analysis and the removal of the soiling the stucco was painted using a 'Keim' mineral paint to closely match the colour and texture originally applied to the surface.

Results

The exterior envelope was made weather tight to guarantee its future and in the process the property was re-instated expressing its original style.
