

DORCHESTER HOTEL - Ceramics

Challenge

To clean and repair a pair of large 330-kilogram decorative white marble urns constructed in four interlocking sections set on wooden pedestals. One urn was severely damaged when it toppled from its pedestal and therefore required extensive repairs.

Solution

Both urns were returned to our workshop, lightly cleaned and the damaged urn repaired and re-assembled. For stability internal metal supports and bracing were designed and fitted to ensure that the four sections of each urn and the wooden pedestals functioned as a single more stable unit.

Results

On completion the pair of urns was returned to the lobby at the Dorchester Hotel and reinstated for the continuing pleasure of the Guests.
